





## ART & LANGUAGE

- I La troisième partie à gauche de L'enterrement à Ornans de Courtet est l'expression d'une impression volupturuse qui, en soulerant la question de l'autonomie du spectature romme s'apré de la peiturue élle-même (en posant le spectature romme détaché et dérivant dans de tres profondes et tres vagues réminiscences immersément généralisées qui sont reliées à une coessistence volupteureus et qui, à cerains moments, se confondent dans la sensation d'une fusion) souche aux angioises archaiques. 

"AIDS (Wallpaper)" is one aspect of the collective activism around the AIDS epidemic. The wallpaper's repeating logo is based on the well-known LOVE motif by mid-1960s artist Robert Indiana, of which General Idea was appropriated starting in 1987, exploiting the familiarity of the icon to communicate a message relevant to a new historical moment, as AIDS was becoming an international serious problem.




In Brecht's poster the phrase "No Smoking" written in black simply stands out in the white space. 
"This historic limited edition poster was created by Frank Stella as a show of solidarity and to raise funds for the Attica Defense Fund, which was created to aid the inmates charged during the 1971 riots. Fans of popular culture recognize the word "ATTICA" - made famous by Al Pacino in the 1975 movie "Dog Day Afternoon" when his character, Sonny, a bank robber, invokes the famous prison riots and subsequent murder trials by taking to the streets and shouting, like a mantra "Attica, Attica, Attica..." The Attica Prison uprising, also known as the Attica Prison rebellion or Attica Prison riot, occurred at the Attica Correctional Facility in Attica, New York, United States, in 1971. Based upon prisoners' demands for better living conditions and political rights, the uprising was one of the most well-known and significant uprisings of the Prisoners' Rights Movement. As a result of the Attica uprisings, 43 people died, and in 1975 an Attica Defense Fund was created to help pay the legal fees for many of those involved. 
